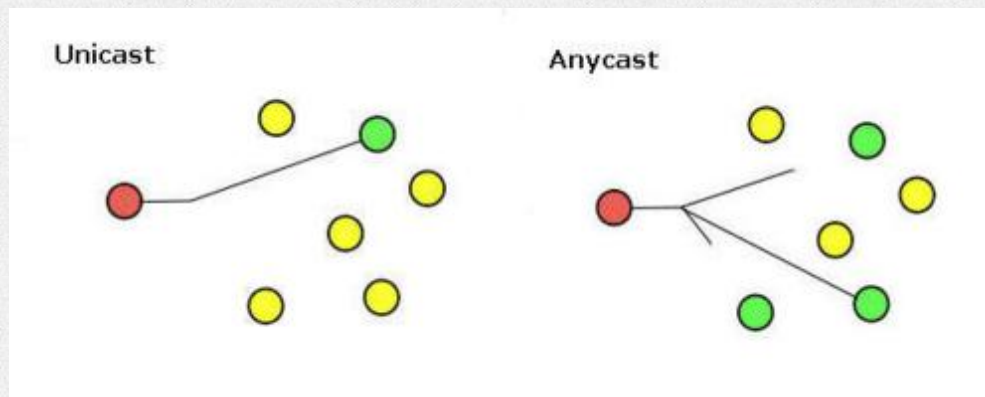
Auth NS infrastructure for 3 TLD zones

6 anycast clusters

- No more unicast servers since 2013
- 4 anycast clusters managed in house
 - consisting of 12 servers in 9 locations
 - BNIX, AMSIX, NIX.CZ, NL-IX, LINX, NetNod, MIX
- 2 clusters managed by third parties
 - Over 50 locations worldwide

Anycast

- Many machines, one IP



- Benefits
 - Connection is made to the nearest node
 - Resilience
 - Ideal for DNS traffic

DNS Belgium – BNIX

- Why is BNIX important for DNS Belgium ?

Belgian ccTLD in the Belgian Internet Exchange

- Provide fast and reliable DNS services
- 3 anycast nodes in 3 different clusters connected on the BNIX network
- Close to Belgian users

Local Anycast Node

Ongoing project in which we provide transparent private access towards our DNS infrastructure

Why ?

- DDoS mitigation

Who ?

- Initially for large Belgian ISP's
- Now also open for other parties

How ?

- Direct peering/private peering
